The Island and Cru

On September 6th 2017, Hurricane Irma caused innumerable damage as it passed through the Caribbean. The Caribbean island of St. Maarten was one of the most affected by the passage of this cyclone leaving a toll of four lethal victims and dozens injured.

As of February of 2016 Panamanian students under the coordination of Cru Panama traveled to St. Maarten, this concluded with a working relationship with pastors in the island so that more people came to know Jesus. Since this mission, the island has been of vital importance, interest and above all, commitment on behalf Cru Panama, which even after the passage of the hurricane joins with the desire to support the island with a helping hand, words of encouragement, community work and prayers.



Objective of the project.

Offering social and spiritual support to families in the island of St. Maarten affected by the passage of the hurricane. It is important to stretch our hands to provide support and words of hope to the islanders.



Needs of the island.

The priority needs are:

- Food.
- Articles of personal hygiene.
- The registration of families for subsequent monitoring
- Support in the cleaning of houses and places most affected by the hurricane



Our Response to the needs.

We will be conducting a trip consisting of at least 6 volunteer missionaries to carry all the collected food, using the collected funds to acquire resources in the island and donating them to families.



Added to this, there is a series of activities aimed at sharing with families, prayer times, spiritual conversations, exploration of the island for further support projects.



Investment needed.

In addition to the Economic donation that we wish to carry out on the island, this project requires a minimum investment of \$ 7000.00 USD to cover the expenses of air fares, ground transportation, lodging and food for the missionaries.
